**NOTICE OF RACE**

**1 RULES**

- 1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

**2 ADVERTISING**

- 2.1** Advertising will be restricted to Category A.

**3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1** The regatta is open to all boats of the Scorpion class.
- 3.2** Eligible boats may enter by completing an entry form on the day and paying the entry fee.

**4 FEES**

- 4.1** The entry fee is £15 per boat.

**5 SCHEDULE**

- 5.1** Registration will be from 10.00am on Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> in the clubhouse.
- 5.2** six races will be sailed. 3 ON SATURDAY:- TWO BACK TO BACK THEN BREAK THEN ONE RACE THEN 3 SUNDAY :- TWO BACK TO BACK LUNCH THEN ONE RACE .
- 5.3** The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on Saturday is 1.00 pm. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race on Sunday is 10.30 am.

**6 MEASUREMENTS**

- 6.1** Boats competing in the EVENT shall have a valid measurement certificate.

**7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be available after at the registration desk

**8 THE COURSES**

- 8.1** The courses to be sailed will use the club marks a plan of which will be available with the sailing instructions.

**9 SCORING**

**9.1** 2 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

**9.2** When 3 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

**10 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

**11 PRIZES**

Prizes will be given to the first 3 boats in each fleet and additional spot prizes may be awarded.

**12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

**13 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2 000 000 per event or the equivalent.
